## SCENARIOS FOR CASH OR CHEQUE REFUNDS

| Scenario | How to refund the balance of the retainer |

| \#1 - Lawyer receives greater than $\$ 7,500$ cash in a lump sum <br> - Lawyer request an $\$ 8,000$ retainer for legal services <br> - Client provides an $\$ 8,000$ cash retainer <br> - Lawyer bills the client $\$ 5,000$ <br> - Lawyer must refund $\$ 3,000$ | The lawyer must refund the $\$ 3,000$ in cash because the lawyer received an amount greater than $\$ 7,500$ cash |
| \#2 - Lawyer receives greater than \$7,500 cash in the aggregate <br> - Lawyer requests a $\$ 5,000$ retainer for legal services <br> - Client provides \$5,000 cash retainer <br> - Lawyer bills the client $\$ 5,000$ <br> - Lawyer requests a further retainer <br> - Client provides a $\$ 3,000$ cash retainer <br> - Client provided $\$ 8,000$ in cash in the aggregate <br> - Lawyer bills the client $\$ 1,000$ <br> - Lawyer must refund $\$ 2,000$ | The lawyer must refund the $\$ 2,000$ in cash because the lawyer received an amount greater that $\$ 7,500$ cash in the aggregate |
| \#3 - Lawyer receives less than \$7,500 cash <br> - Lawyer requests a $\$ 7,000$ retainer for legal services <br> - Client provides a $\$ 7,000$ cash retainer <br> - Lawyer bills the client $\$ 4,000$ <br> - Lawyer must refund $\$ 3,000$ | The lawyer is not required to provide a cash refund because the client provided less than $\$ 7,500$ in cash. The lawyer may make the refund by trust cheque. |
| \#4 - Lawyer receives a combination of cash and cheque <br> - Lawyer requests a $\$ 10,000$ retainer for legal services <br> - Client provides an $\$ 8,000$ cash retainer and a $\$ 2,000$ cheque <br> - Lawyer bills the client $\$ 7,000$ <br> - Lawyer must refund $\$ 3,000$ | The lawyer must refund the $\$ 3,000$ in cash because the lawyer received an amount greater than $\$ 7,500$ cash |
